Full of Grace, Fourths take another flag! by Warwick Hadfield

"Courage is Grace under Pressure" – Ernest Hemingway.

Aidan Grace produced the courageous, graceful, pressurised, precious, "freakish", find your own adjective, all-round performance to take the Newtown and Chilwell Men's **Fourth XI to** a second premiership in a row last weekend.

"He is a freak," said his jubilant skipper, Jordan White.

"The second he gets a whiff of finals, he is unstoppable, he is made for it.

"He dug in with the bat in conditions that weren't batter friendly.

"We were lucky to get the score we did, thanks to Aidan who in the past has always been asked to survive as a batsman.

"I think we can now say he is beyond that; he is now an all-rounder."

As Knackers will happily tell you, it was not Aidan's first Fourth XI flag.

In the summer of 2020/21, he was the silent partner in a last wicket partnership with Matt Scott to win the premiership.

This summer, his contribution was stentorian, first with the bat, his 38 down the order the compelling feature of a curate's egg of a Two Blue innings of 133.

Then with the ball, and in cahoots with another young bloke who can cope with grand final pressure, Jack Gordon – his second flag in a row and third overall.

Aidan bowled 17 overs for 17 runs, five wickets, and everyone's player of the match award.

Flash Jack, like Aidan snagging the edge of tentative bats on the way to the ever-eager Madden Sadowy, took four wickets, leaving Levi West to rattle the five wooden things for the winning wicket, the moment followed by unabashed Two Blue pandemonium, South Barwon all out for 54: Brum barump bara.

With only one batter in the top six managing double figures early on day one, something graceful, courageous, freakish and more was needed from the tail.

The captain will be one of those talking, but he was also full of praise for Aidan's bowling partner with whom he ripped apart the South Barwon reply.

"Jack has bowled his arse off for the entire season, just like Aidan, you know what you're going to get when you toss him the ball and I want to place this on the record, he is too good to be playing Fourths.

It won't be too long before the same is said of Madden Sadowy, who held six catches behind the wickets (a club record) and saved a lot of runs down the leg-side.

"We made the call on him being the keeper a few games ago," Jordan White said.

"His performance was outstanding, we backed him, and he repaid us, he took six catches, and a few ripper stops down the leg-side, they knew they couldn't nudge the ball around the corner because of the way he was moving, covering the ground."

And the win itself, given that other flag in which Jordan and a few of his team-mates had shared under the captaincy of Adam O'Connor.



"This was something special," the newly minted Fourth XI premiership captain said. "We played them earlier in the year, got a lot of runs and bowled them out really cheaply.



"Before the game we spoke about how they would come out, whether they would have a point to prove and I think they were pretty confident at the start of day two but once they lost early wickets, they just fell away.

"It was all credit to us in the field, the bowlers, everyone."

Knottie's Thirds tried their damndest to make it two celebrations but with only 126, Rocket and Poves best with the bat, to defend, it was always going to be tough.

"We piled on the pressure; we just couldn't get the two breakthroughs in a row we needed," he said.

"The Sargeant bowled his heart out, and everyone one of us left everything on the pitch, but we just couldn't get there."

"The Sargeant" of course as regular readers would know is Brendan Twaddle, who earned a mention in dispatches from both captains after bowling 28 overs into the wind, maiden after maiden, to take 3-29.

Poves backed up his innings with a three-for and the skipper held a screamer of Angus Duff searching for that double breakthrough, but South Barwon got home by three wickets.

As hard as the loss was, Knottie and his team-mates went to the rooms to be part of the Fourth XI's celebrations. There was a lot of grace about that, too.
